

It teaches basic Arcview functionality and enables participants to quickly take advantage of the software's powerful display and analysis capabilities. Attendees are introduced to the Arcview GIS GUI (graphic user interface) and use Arcview GIS to create, edit, display, query, and analyze geographic and tabular data and create presentation-quality maps and charts.</p>	<p><b>Advanced Arcview 3.x:</b></p> <p>This 3 day course offer participants in-depth instruction in Arcview 3.x software's ability to integrate geographic information. Attendees move beyond the basics as they perform GIS analysis using the software's total functionality including new geoprocessing tools and projection utility. The course helps participants become more productive Arcview GIS users by teaching them advance topics such as using sample scripts and extensions, converting them into map projections, and making projects portable. Realistic class projects and challenging hands on exercises let participants immediately apply their newly acquired skills.</p>
