Ronald E. Miller became the agency's Chief Information Officer and Assistant Director for the Information Technology Services Directorate in October 2001. Mr. Miller manages and operates FEMA's information technology and telecommunications systems, and provides information technology and telecommunications services to FEMA and other federal, state and local agencies when required. Mr. Miller joined FEMA in June 2001 as the agency's Deputy Chief Information Officer and Deputy Assistant Director for the Information Technology Services Directorate.

Prior to joining FEMA, Mr. Miller was a team leader and information technology project manager at PricewaterhouseCoopers in Tampa, Fla. He also spent eight years with Science Applications International Corporation in such positions as senior requirements analyst, project manager and division manager at various sites, including Satellite Beach and Tampa, Fla., and Stuttgart, Germany.

Mr. Miller served in the U.S. Air Force as an air intelligence officer, attaining the rank of Captain. His awards include the Meritorious Service Medal and the Air Force Commendation Medal.
