Trey Reid: Deputy Assistant Director, Readiness, Response and Recovery

Trey Reid was appointed Deputy Assistant Director for Readiness, Response and Recovery in June 2001, after an agency-wide reorganization. In this position, he manages the day-to-day operations of the six divisions within the directorate and interacts with Congressional, federal, state, tribal and local officials, and the private sector. He previously served as the Deputy Associate Director for the Preparedness, Training and Exercises Directorate.
