Daniel A. Craig: Regional Director, Region I

Daniel A. Craig was appointed Regional Director of FEMA's Region I in September 2001. As Regional Director, Mr. Craig's responsibilities include FEMA prevention, preparedness, training and response and recovery activities in six states: Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont and Rhode Island.

Prior to joining FEMA, Mr. Craig was executive director of the Eastern Regional Office of the Chamber of Commerce. In this post, Mr. Craig was responsible for chamber-related legislative, political, and media initiatives in New England and the Atlantic coast.

Previously, he was a legislative representative for the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association in Arlington, Va. There he handled issues of federal emergencies, transportation, technology, privacy and energy. He also worked as a grassroots specialist for the organization. Earlier in his career, Mr. Craig worked as a campaign advisor, and political fundraiser and research analyst.

A native of Wallingford, Conn., Mr. Craig holds a bachelor of art's degree in political science from Purdue University in West Lafayette, Ind.
